 - Conducting doubt-clearing sessions.
 - Administering slip tests and quizzes to reinforce concepts.
- Mentors will monitor the progress of students attending remedial classes and provide feedback to the respective subject teachers.
- Subscribed to additional e-books and journals through **Knimbus** and **National Digital Library of India** for enhanced digital learning.

2. Feedback from Teaching Faculty





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

Graphical Analysis of Teachers' Feedback response


